Local Pilgrim Places

Local Pilgrim Places for Jubilee 2025

For locals wanting to participate in [this] year's Jubilee and unable to travel to Rome, we have good news. The Catholic Archdiocese of Melbourne has designated 13 churches and shrines within the Archdiocese as Pilgrim Places for the purposes of the 2025 Jubilee, with the majestic St Patrick's Cathedral serving as the principal Pilgrim Place.

The other designated pilgrim places are: St Mary Star of the Sea (Archdiocese Shrine of the Holy Family), West Melbourne; St Mary MacKillop, Keilor Downs; St Luke's, Lalor; St Mary Magdalene's, Trentham; Polish Marian Shrine, Aberfeldie/Essendon; St Dominic's, Camberwell East; St Francis Xavier, Mansfield; Sacred Heart, Croydon; Divine Mercy Shrine, Keysborough; Our Lady of La Vang, Keysborough; St Patrick's, Mentone; and St Macartan's. Mornington.

Plenary Indulgence

To receive a Jubilee plenary indulgence within the Archdiocese of Melbourne, individually or in a group, people can visit any Pilgrim Place, remain there for a suitable period of time, engage in Eucharistic adoration and meditation, then conclude their time of prayer with the Our Father, the Profession of Faith and the Hail Mary (or any other invocation to Mary the Mother of God).

By fulfilling these conditions while they are at a Pilgrim Place, the grace of the Jubilee Indulgence is granted.

A word from Fr Anthony

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, I wish you and your family a blessed Sunday and a beautiful week ahead.

This Sunday, instead of celebrating the Third Sunday in Ordinary Time (C), the Church celebrates the Feast of the Presentation of Jesus in the temple. This Feast is celebrated on the 2nd of February each year and this year it falls on this Sunday. The Presentation, which is celebrated 40 days after Christmas, is not mentioned in the other Gospels. Only Luke tells the story, most likely because he writes for Gentile Christians who are not familiar with the Jewish rite of presentation and purification. In addition, the intent of Luke's Gospel is to show that God's promise to Israel, fulfilled in Jesus, extends to Gentiles.

We can see in this Sunday's gospel the fact that Luke recognizes Joseph and Mary as faithful Jews who bring Jesus to the Temple in Jerusalem. Here they present their firstborn son to the Lord. Jesus is thus consecrated as required by the Law of Moses: "You will dedicate to the Lord every newborn that opens the womb" (Exodus 13:12). This detail calls us to look at our own self and ask: "What can I dedicate to the Lord?" or "Do I have something to offer or to tell God each time I attend the mass or come to God in the moments of prayer?"

Dear brothers and sisters, present in the temple at the time Joseph and Mary presented Jesus in the Temple are Simeon and Anna. Both are awaiting the restoration of God's rule in Israel. Simeon had been promised by the Holy Spirit that he would see Christ the Lord, the Messiah, before he died. The holy man immediately recognized the infant Jesus as the promised Savior, a "light for revelation to the Gentiles, and glory for your people Israel" (Lk 2:32). Anna also recognized Jesus as the fulfillment of the promise of redemption and spoke about him to all. Let us join Simeon and Anna in recognizing Jesus as our Savior and as the revelation of God, who loves us unconditionally!
